#### Understanding the Heart of Jesus

On September 22, 2024, Hatcher celebrated its 102<sup>nd</sup> anniversary. Two years ago Hatcher walked toward its Centennial Anniversary with joy, hope, and expectation. 2022 was a year to cherish and remember. The *Herald* note to you this month is "**Sharpe Hindsight**" not insight. <u>Hindsight</u> challenges us to learn from our past, <u>Insight</u> challenges us to view with depth into our present, <u>Foresight</u> challenges us to look with vision to our future. As we look back, may we relearn and see the simple things Jesus taught our forefathers and Mothers who helped Hatcher to grow to become the Church Family it is today...102 years later into our present.

During Jesus' ministry on earth, He challenged his listeners. In fact, Jesus often spoke in parables, or in metaphors. He used figurative language to relate common objects or concepts with Himself or His Kingdom so that people could better understand his character, his purpose, and ultimately, his heart. In the book of John, there are seven times in which Jesus says, "I am" Each statement gives us a glimpse into God's character and understand the very heart of Jesus.

**Jesus, "I am the Bread of Life."** *"Then Jesus declared, 'I am the bread of life. He who comes to me will never go hungry, and he who believes in me will never be thirsty." (John 6:35)* 

**Jesus, "I am the Light of the World."** "When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life." (John 8:12)

**Jesus, "I am the Door."** "I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture." (John 10:9)

**Jesus, "I am the Good Shepherd."** "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." (John 10:11)

**Jesus, "I am the Resurrection and the Life."** *Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25-26)* 

**Jesus, "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life."** *Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6)* 

**Jesus, "I am the Vine."** "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing." (John 15:5)

When confronted by the burning bush, Moses asked, "Who are you?"...God's reply was, "I AM THAT(WHO) I AM". Today, let us be reminded, "Jesus is the Great I AM who loves us!!"


