
I look forward to reestablishing relationships and forging new ones! I urge you to contact me with any needs or celebrations you have.

The Endowment Fund has truly been blessed since its inception in 1983.

Contributions plus reinvestment of earnings from these contributions have enabled the fund to grow and provide resources and assistance for a number of authorized

undertakings. In recent years, the Endowment Fund has received minimal contributions and the increase in value has been through investment earnings. Copies of the Endowment guidelines are available outside the Church office.

One of the permitted uses of Endowment funds is disaster assistance.

Recently Hatcher's Endowment Fund provided \$5,000 to the Baptist General Association of Virginia (BGAV) designated for assistance in the recovery from Hurricane Helene in the Damascus Virginia area. The BGAV currently has teams working in Damascus and other areas of western Virginia helping with recovery from disastrous flooding. They have teams scheduled through February 2025, initially helping with cleanup, and now rebuilding. The following is a list of Endowment Fund disbursements since inception.
