
THE INTERIM PASTOR'S PEN...

Preparation: Find a comfortable, quiet space where you can sit upright, uninterrupted. Take a few deep breaths, allowing your body to relax.

Begin:

Visualize the Garden: Imagine yourself standing in a serene garden at the break of dawn. The air is cool, and the first rays of sunlight are gently filtering through the trees, casting long shadows on the dewy grass.

Empty Tomb: As you walk deeper into the garden, you see a stone rolled away from a tomb. The tomb is empty, and a sense of peace and wonder fills the air.



Presence of Mary Magdalene: A woman, Mary Magdalene, is kneeling near the tomb, her face filled with a mixture of sadness and joy. She looks up, her eyes filled with disbelief, then recognition as she sees a figure standing before her.

The Risen Christ: This figure is Jesus, radiant with light, his hands outstretched, offering a gentle smile. He is alive, and his presence is filled with love and compassion.

Reflect on Transformation: As you gaze at Jesus, reflect on the meaning of his resurrection. Think about the struggles you've faced in your life, the darkness you've encountered, and how his triumph over death symbolizes the possibility of renewal and rebirth within yourself.

Embrace New Life: Imagine yourself stepping into the light emanating from Jesus, feeling the weight of negativity lifting as you are enveloped in his love. Feel a sense of hope, forgiveness, and a renewed spirit.

Personal Connection: In this moment of connection, whisper a prayer or silent reflection about the areas in your life where you desire renewal. Perhaps it's a new perspective on a challenging situation, a fresh start in a relationship, or simply a renewed commitment to self-care.

Carry the Light: As you begin to gently open your eyes, carry the warmth of this experience with you throughout your day. Remember that even in the face of darkness, the promise of new life and hope is always present.
